Description: The Illinois House and Senate passed landmark transit legislation early in the morning on Friday, October 31st, just before the close of the fall legislative session. SB2111, which will be sent to the governor's desk and is expected to be signed into law, includes an estimated amount of more than \$1 billion in new operating funding for the regional transit system. Staff will provide an overview of the bill.

Description: The proposed ordinance revises 2026 operating funding amounts and estimates for 2027-28 and required recovery ratios for CTA, Metra, Pace Suburban Service, and ADA Paratransit, based on SB2111. The funding estimates for the 2026-2030 Capital Program are unchanged at this time.
